

2022 Spring Meeting

President Paul DePauw called role. Secretary Tony Marchand distributed the minutes from the fall 2021 meeting. The motion by Riley DeBrock, second by Glen Hostens III to approve minutes.

Treasurer Lynn Baele gave the financial report. The current balance is \$62.26. The motion to approve was made by Glen Hostens III second by Carl Suhr.

The 3 motions from the fall 2021 meeting all passed.

Motion 1- Much like a few major pro sports -create a "Wild Card" for the Western League Championship. The league would take the top 3 men's points accumulators (that did not make championship for their respective clubs) who have played a minimum of 7 games for the year and they would then form a "Wild Card" team to make a 12th team for the Western League Championship. These men form a team regardless of the club they played for throughout the season. **Passed 7-4**

Motion 2- Remove the rule that says every club has the right to represent itself in Championship. **Passed 7-4**

Motion 3- When a club does not have three players that make seven games, they have to play with the number of players that have made seven games. If the club does not have any players that attended seven games, they must forfeit. **Passed 8-3**
